Why We Meditate on the Theophanies of God

Let's redirect as to why we are meditating on the theophanies of God! We are doing this because, I believe, theophanies are an ideal starting point for our prayers so that we too can pray to God as He has revealed Himself. When you pray the theophanies, we will discover God is not far, but really near.

In other theophanies, you will be introduced into sights, sounds and smells of heaven—see who it is you are talking to. Another benefit is gaining confidence that God really wants to hear your prayers and that you are addressing the one full of power, who is in charge of heaven and earth. The other great thing to expect in praying from meditation of theophanies is to grow in deeper intimacy. Relationship with God changes!

Each one of His attributes will be poured out through revelation. Intimacy and communion will flow between you and God as Holy Spirit unveils God the Father and the Son, revealing to us more and more of Christ each day.

Praying from the theophanies, we begin to touch His power, to hear that loud voice like many waters, to tremble in the presence of the thunder and lightning bolts. What I also realize is seeing God for who He is, not who we think He is! So I encourage us all to a revelation of an entirely different world that exists beyond this world we live in. God has a heavenly council that convenes to discuss affairs on earth.

Moses cried, “Show me your glory.” This is the powerful cry and intercession of Moses.

“And Moses said to the Lord, If Your Presence does not go with me, do not carry us up from here! For by what shall it be known that I and Your people have found favor in Your sight? Is it not in Your going with us so that we are distinguished, I and Your people, from all the other people upon the face of the earth?

And the Lord said to Moses, I will do this thing also that you have asked, for you have found favor, loving-kindness, and mercy in My sight and I know you personally and by my name. [Rev. 2:17.] And Moses said, I beseech You, show me Your glory. And God said, I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim My name, THE Lord, before you; for I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy and loving-kindness on whom I will show mercy and loving-kindness. [Rom. 9:15, 16.]

But, He said, You can not see My face, for no man shall see Me and live.

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And the Lord said, Behold, there is a place beside Me, and you shall stand upon the rock, And while My glory passes by, I will put you in a cleft of the rock and cover you with My hand until I have passed by. Then I will take away My hand and you shall see My back; but My face shall not be seen.”
