Day 18 – Fascinated By Beauty

"Behold, you are fair (beautiful), My love! Behold, you are fair! You have dove's eyes."
(Song 1:15)

He tells her that she has dove's eyes. A dove has no peripheral vision. It can only look straight ahead. Meaning, it is not distracted by what's going on to the left or the right. It can't look at multiple things at once. By telling her, she has dove's eyes, He's saying that her eyes are only focused and fixated on Him and that moves His heart.

In verse 16 she declares "You are beautiful, my Beloved."

I believe she began to have the same heart revelation that David had that made him known as the man after God's own heart.

David was a young man and just like everyone else before and after him, apart from Jesus; he was a broken and sinful man. But he was gripped with this revelation and vision that he could actually discover and experience the beauty of the Lord. That became his life goal.

"One thing I have desired of the Lord, That I will seek; That I may dwell in the house of the Lord All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the Lord, And to inquire in His temple." Psalms 27:4

I pray we all get gripped by this heart.

Let's not be satisfied with a few bible verses, financial stability and ministry skills. Let's lock into this vision: I am going to experience more of the beauty of who Jesus is.

Now something like this isn't going to happen in just a moment. This isn't something that will happen by accident or just by reading a few verses. It requires time, quiet, and a willingness to shut out distractions. It calls for patience and a deep, persistent hunger for more of Him. It's not a one-time thing, it's a lifelong pursuit.

How do you feel about taking that step toward intentional focus, setting aside time, and cultivating that "dove's eyes" perspective? There is a beautiful invitation here to go deep in intimacy. I believe the Lord wants to draw us in to be fascinated with His beauty.
