March 31, 2025 – Song of Songs: The Journey into Wholehearted Love – Rendu Paras

Day 31 – Revelation of Jesus' Safe Leadership (Song 3:6-11)

This is the fourth revelation of Jesus in the Song. In this passage Jesus is seen as a safe savior. As she is holding on to Him, the Bride gains a revelation of the Bridegroom's safe leadership as He leads her out of the wilderness of a fallen world. He's described as being surrounded by 60 of the most heroic soldiers. She gets a revelation that being with Him is the safest place to be, even if it means facing the tallest mountains.

Walking on the water with Jesus is safer than being on the boat without Him. Of course, this quote is referring to the passage in Matthew 14, John 6 and Mark 6. Just after feeding the 5000 Jesus sends His disciples ahead of Him by boat to cross the sea of Galilee. After several hours into the night, the disciples are hit with this massive storm. Understandably, the disciples were afraid but then they look out and see Jesus walking on the water in the middle of the storm. This is a powerful picture. I personally don't have much experience with being on a boat, but I can definitely tell you that I'd much rather be on the boat instead of the water if there's a storm. And yet, if that's where Jesus is, that instantly becomes the safest place to be. That's the revelation that God wants the Bride to have. He wants her to trust Him completely. That no matter what she experiences or faces, no matter what situation He is leading her through, if He is the one leading, she can take courage. This will be an essential revelation in the End Times. The world will face an unprecedented pressure and in the face of that, the church must be able to trust Him in order to not fall.
