Day 64 – Partnering in Love: Intercession for Power

“Come, my Beloved, let us go forth to the field; let us lodge in the villages. Let us get up early to the vineyards; let us see if the vine has budded, whether the grape blossoms are open, and the pomegranates are in bloom. There I will give You my love.” (Song of Songs 7:11–12)

Once you know you’re desired by God (v.10), your heart naturally says: *“Let us go.”* Love doesn’t sit still. It moves. It reaches. It partners. This is where intimacy becomes intercession.

The Bride is no longer thinking only of her personal encounters. Her heart is now burning with His desire for others. She invites Jesus into the *field*, into the places of harvest, of ministry, of everyday life. She’s not going alone. She says, *“Let us go... Let us lodge... Let us get up early.”* She’s moving with Him, not just for Him.

This is the essence of true intercession: not striving to earn God’s power, but partnering with Him out of love, asking Him to come and move through us. She walks among the budding vines, the blossoming grapes, the blooming pomegranates, not just observing, but praying, investing, loving.

These are people and ministries in process. Still maturing. Still growing. And she values them deeply. Why? Because they belong to Him. And in this hidden place of labor, she gives Him her love, not just in worship, but in willingness.

There in the field, in the villages, in the unseen corners of the Kingdom, she gives Him her love.

Let your love go beyond the secret place today. Let it touch people. Let it become prayer. Let it shape how you show up in your job, your family, your neighborhood. This is partnership. This is wholehearted love in motion.
