Day 69 – Love That Cannot Be Quenched (Song 8:6–7)

“Many waters cannot quench love, neither can floods drown it...” (Song of Songs 8:7)

God’s love is indestructible. It doesn’t fade in suffering, nor drown in hardship. The love that Jesus seals upon our hearts is not a fragile emotion, it’s a divine flame that cannot be extinguished. This is the love that burned in His heart as He went to the cross. It is the same love He longs to awaken in us.

When the pressures of life come, when sin, fear, or grief try to pull us away, this love holds us steady. “Many waters” symbolize trials, temptations, and spiritual resistance, yet none of them can put out the fire that God Himself has kindled within us.

But here’s the mystery: this love is both unstoppable and optional. God doesn’t force it. He waits for our “yes.” He desires a Bride who responds freely to His pursuit. Jesus will not break down the door of our hearts. He gently knocks and waits for us to open (Rev. 3:20). The seal of love becomes ours only when we invite Him to place it there.

This divine love is a gift of the Holy Spirit. It’s not earned by striving; it’s received by yielding. As we set our hearts to love Jesus with everything, the Holy Spirit strengthens us with fire from above. He empowers us to love God with the same love the Father has for the Son.

Today, you may feel overwhelmed by “many waters”, busyness, pain, confusion, or dryness. But none of these can drown the flame He has placed within you. The seal of His love is stronger.

This is what it means to be His: to carry His fire, to burn with the very flame of God.
