Day 71 – What Shall We Do for Her? (Part 1)

The Bride's Heart for the Immature

“We have a little sister, and she has no breasts. What shall we do for our sister in the day when she is spoken for?” — Song of Songs 8:8

As the journey of love matures, something shifts in the Bride's heart. Her passion is no longer just personal, it becomes intercessory. She begins to carry what Jesus carries. She starts to see others through the lens of love.

“We have a little sister...” These words reveal something powerful. The Bride identifies with Jesus in caring for the immature. She doesn't dismiss the little sister for being weak or underdeveloped, she takes responsibility for her. And not just individually, she speaks in partnership: “We.” Love joins Jesus in His mission.

This is the overflow of real love: it reaches beyond itself. The Bride is no longer content just to grow in intimacy; she wants to help others grow too. The spiritual maturity she's gained isn't used to elevate herself but to lift someone else.

This moment in the Song is deeply prophetic. It shows the heart of a people who have gone deep in love and now look outward, not in judgment, but in tenderness. They're asking, “How can we help her grow? How can we help her be ready for her day of destiny?”

You may be further along in your walk but who is your little sister? Who has God placed around you that needs nurturing, encouragement, or covering? This is not just leadership, it's love. And the Holy Spirit is forming a Church that doesn't quit on people, but stays with them until they mature in love.
