Day 74 – Becoming One Who Found Peace

“I am a wall, and my breasts like towers; then I became in His eyes as one who found peace.”
(Song of Songs 8:10)

There comes a time in the journey when the one who was once immature, unsure, and in need of covering has become a source of covering herself. The transformation is quiet but profound. She declares with confidence: “I am a wall... then I became in His eyes as one who found peace.”

She is no longer defined by what she lacks. She knows who she is. She has been enclosed with cedar, clothed in Christ, and now she stands strong, fruitful, and at rest. What once was prayerful intercession has become spiritual stature. What once was longing has become identity.

She doesn’t live to be seen by others. She lives before the eyes of the One. She has found peace, not in her circumstances, but in His gaze. The Lord has shaped her into someone who reflects His character, steadfast, nurturing, and secure. She ministers from overflow, nourishes from maturity, and protects others out of love.

This is the goal of love’s journey: not simply to feel God’s love, but to become love. The Bride no longer just receives; she gives. She no longer asks to be held up; she holds others up. She is a wall, a tower, and a testimony of grace.

Reflection:

This stage of love is marked by peace, strength, and quiet authority. It’s what happens when the character of Christ has been built into someone’s life over time, through tears, worship, obedience, and joy. Her confidence is not a passing emotion, it is the fruit of being known and loved by God, and of knowing Him in return. This is wholehearted love made visible.
