Day 77 – Let Me Hear Your Voice

“You who dwell in the gardens, the companions listen for your voice—Let Me hear it!”
(Song of Songs 8:13)

As the journey of love nears its final verses, we hear one more tender call from the King. It’s not a command, it’s a longing. A yearning.

“Let Me hear your voice.”

The Bride has not withdrawn. She still dwells among the gardens, among the people of God. She’s not hiding or isolating herself. She’s still present, still serving, still loving, and her voice still carries authority, tenderness, and power. Others are listening. But even more, Jesus is listening.

He wants to hear you. Your voice moves Him.

You may not always feel that your voice matters, but the King says otherwise. Your song of worship, your whispered prayers, your encouragements, your witness, they are all beautiful to Him. He’s not asking for perfection; He’s asking for your presence.

The Lord delights to hear your voice in four ways:

1. In worship – when we declare our love back to the One who first loved us.
2. In intercession – when we partner with His heart and pray His purposes into the earth (Heb. 7:25).
3. In teaching – when we build up others by speaking the truth in love (Matt. 28:19–20).
4. In evangelism – when we share the good news with those who don’t yet know Him.

The enemy will do anything to silence your voice. He knows the power of a Bride who speaks from love, from truth, from confidence. But Jesus says, “Let Me hear it.”

Don’t hold back. Speak. Sing. Pray. Declare. Love.

He is listening.
