Day 78 – Hastening

“Make haste, my Beloved, and be like a gazelle or a young stag on the mountains of spices.”
—Song of Songs 8:14

We’ve reached the final verse in the Song of Songs. The journey ends not with a quiet farewell, but with a bold cry of longing: “Make haste, my Beloved!”

This is the heart of the mature Bride. No longer hesitant or reserved, she is confident in love. Her journey has led her to this place, a place where her greatest desire is not just to serve Him, but to be with Him. She has come through trials and testing. She has learned to rest, to trust, and to love. And now she cries out for His return.

This cry, “Come quickly!”, isn’t just about escape from pain. It’s about union. It’s about longing for the fullness of His presence, first in intimacy, then in revival, and finally in glory.

Jesus is the gazelle, the young stag, swift and strong. He is the One who leaps over every obstacle, who comes in power, and who conquers every mountain to reach His Bride.

This final cry contains three layers of desire:

1. Come near us – in personal intimacy. Jesus, awaken love in our hearts again.
2. Come to us – in revival. Jesus, move in our cities and nations with power.
3. Come for us – in Your return. Jesus, we long for the day You appear in glory.

This is the call of the Church at the end of the age. The Spirit and the Bride are united in one cry: “Come!” (Revelation 22:17)

And we don’t just cry upward, we call outward too. We invite others to encounter the Bridegroom, to know His love, to join in this sacred longing.

Your voice matters. Your longing is holy. The cry in your heart to see Jesus face-to-face is the very echo of heaven.

So let your voice rise. Join the song of the ages.
