### **THE FURIOUS JESUS**

#### **THE DISCLOSURE OF THE END OF THE AGE IS THE ‘REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST’ (REVELATION 1:1)**

#### **THE FAMILIAR JESUS (Isaiah 53)**

We are familiar, and more comfortable with, the Jesus covered in His own blood. This is a true and faithful revelation of Jesus, but it is a partial and not full revelation of Jesus.

He is everything Adam could not be. He is the seed of the woman who will crush the seed of the serpent. (Genesis 3:15)

“The Lord will provide Himself a lamb” (Genesis 22:8)

“Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29)

John was looking for a lion but saw a lamb (Revelation 5:9-10,12; Daniel 9:24) We can trust Jesus with Isaiah 63 because of what He did and achieved as described in Isaiah 53.

We can trust Jesus with all power and authority because “He was led like a lamb to the slaughter” (Isaiah 53:7) (Philippians 2:5-9)

#### **THE UNFAMILIAR JESUS (Isaiah 63)**

The Jesus drenched in the blood of His enemies is unfamiliar to us, and we are less comfortable with Him. But it is the same Jesus of Isaiah 53. This is not a quick or cheap battle; it is a holy battle in which the Lord brings an end to all sin and iniquity (vs 2-3, Revelation 14:20)

Psalm 2

“I have set my king on my holy hill” (vs 6)

“I will give you the nations....you shall break them...you shall dash them” (vs 8-9)

“Be wise, o kings....kiss the son, lest he be angry, and you perish in the way”(vs 10-12)

Psalm 110

"Till I make your enemies your footstool" (vs 1)

“He shall judge among the nations” (vs 6)

“He shall fill the places with dead bodies” (vs 6)

“He shall execute the heads of many countries” (vs 6)

“He shall drink of the brook by the wayside, therefore he shall lift up his head” (vs 7)

Zechariah 9 & 14 If we are going to keep a consistent hermeneutic, the literal fulfillment of Zechariah 9:9 means there is coming a literal fulfillment of Zechariah 14:2-4.

## **THE FURIOUS JESUS (2 Thessalonians 1:4-12)**

What does it look like to see this Jesus? How will or should we respond?

The Lord does not ignore our affliction (vs 4-5)

He will settle it in His vengeance (vs 6-9)

When He does, we will adore Him (vs 10)

The Lord alone will be exalted in that day (Isaiah 2:12-17)

Prayer: Father God You heard the prayer of Jesus in John 17... Father we read it too but today help us to hear His cry for His glory to be revealed... His church must see Him not only as a familiar Christ but a furious Christ to once and for all destroy All His enemies!
