DAY 3 – GRACE THAT TRANSFORMS

Titus 2:11–12 NKJV

“For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age.”

Grace is more than pardon; it is power. It does not excuse sin but teaches us to live differently. The grace of God is a tutor, shaping us into people who reflect His holiness in a broken world.

Paul challenges in Romans 6:1–2 NKJV, “Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? Certainly not!” Grace was never meant to be a license to remain as we are. Instead, it makes us new.
