DAY 6 – THE SHOUT OF THE KING

John 13:34–35 NKJV

“A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”

Numbers 23:21 NKJV

“He has not observed iniquity in Jacob, nor has He seen wickedness in Israel. The Lord his God is with him, and the shout of a King is among them.”

The shout of the King is not merely a sound — it is the declaration that God is present among His people. When Israel walked in covenant with God, His presence was their strength, their covering, and their testimony to the nations. Balaam’s prophecy reminds us that the distinguishing mark of God’s people is not perfection, but His presence among them.

Today, as the Church, we are carriers of His presence. His shout is heard when we live in love, walk in unity, and represent His heart to the world. 1 John 4:7 NKJV says, “Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God.” Our love is the clearest evidence that His presence is truly with us.

Paul echoes this in Philippians 2:15 NKJV, “That you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world.” When the shout of the King is among us, His glory is revealed through our compassion, kindness, and witness.
