Ministry to the Lord: Our Highest Privilege and Calling (Day 4)

...when we minister to the Lord, we have one goal in mind, and that is to do something for the Lord. It is not the time to focus on our needs and our desires!

We read about Paul and Silas in prison in Acts 16. We know what happened, at midnight they praised the Lord, God sent an earthquake, their chains fell off and the prison doors were opened.

What is really amazing is that they and the other prisoners remained in the prison and did not flee even although they could have done so. This tells us that their motive for singing praises was not to receive something from God, but to minister to Him because they loved Him.

They had no other agenda!

However, God, being who He is, has a great heart to bless us and will always give us more than He receives.

When our goal is to spend time with Him, praise and worship Him and develop our intimacy with Him, He will often do things for us that we have never even asked for. We read in 1 Corinthians 2:9, "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him."
