The Priority of Ministering to God

God is forever ministered to, around His throne, night and day.

“A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him [His throne, v. 9]. A thousand thousands ministered to Him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him.”

Daniel 7:10
