Daniel 4 – Calling Leaders to Righteousness: The Humbled King (Part 2)

Forerunners Lead Others to Righteousness

Daniel warned the king that he must break off from his sins or he would be humbled. Nebuchadnezzar did not repent. About a year later, he surveyed his accomplishment and concluded that his success was all due to his own great power.

This resulted in a season of seven years in which God humbled him. In His mercy, God had given him a full year to repent (4:29).

“I gave her [Jezebel] time to repent of her sexual immorality, and she did not repent. Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds.”

Rev. 2:21-22

After seven years of insanity and the loss of his prestige, Nebuchadnezzar finally repented. The Lord will raise up forerunners, who at times will call those in leadership over the spheres of society to repent before He humbles them by His judgments and disciplines.

In the end times, God will use his servants to prophesy to various leaders concerning His ways. He will intervene suddenly in their lives and humble them. It will require courage on the part of the Lord’s messengers to call leaders to repentance.

Jesus will humble the leaders of the nations who do not repent (Isa. 2:11-18; 10:12; 25:6).

Practical: To be willing to speak to secular leaders about personal issues in their life.

The forerunner calling includes, but is not limited to, prophesying to those in leadership because a forerunner will not be afraid to speak. They open the way for God to give them time to repent. King Nebuchadnezzar was given a year to repent but didn’t.

Jesus gave Jezebel time to repent but she didn’t. It is an awesome accountability as well as a privilege to carry God’s message.
