Examples of Mercy in the Bible

God's mercy toward you is truly vast. Reading and studying the stories of God showing mercy in the Bible can help you really internalize the depth of his mercy. It doesn't matter what you did, he will forgive you. Ask him for forgiveness.

As you keep reading, you will find 4 examples of mercy in the Bible that will demonstrate the two types of mercy mentioned above. It will help you know his love for you more deeply and see the power of repentance for your own heart, too. This will give you the ability to show mercy to others.

The Ninevites

The Ninevites were people who greatly sinned against God. God hated their sin and sent Jonah to help them turn from their wrongdoings. This was showing them great mercy for their sin against him.

They didn't do anything to deserve this mercy, but God loved them so much. In the book of Jonah, you can see God's heart for these people, even when Jonah didn't think they deserved his mercy.

"And should I not have concern for the great city of Nineveh, in which there are more than a hundred and twenty thousand people who cannot tell their right hand from their left—and also many animals?" (Jonah 4:11, NIV)

In your own life, you don't need to question why you should show mercy—just think about the depth of the mercy God shows you. This can help you show mercy to someone even when you don't think they deserve it or don't understand why you should give it to them.
