### **Let us all pray ....**

1) Pray for our upcoming evangelism outreach in the areas of Rancho Palos Verdes, San Pedro, Carson, Fillmore, Reseda, San Jose, and Long Beach....

*1 Peter 3:15 .... But in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect.*

Empower us to share Your truth, with fervor, love, and grace profoundly. Sow Your Word on fertile ground. Let our words be lanterns bright, igniting hearts with Heaven's Light, to navigate life's stormy seas, directing souls to Your embrace. With humble heart, we plead for strength...To share the Gospel unashamed. To rise above our fear and doubt and let Your Spirit's fire pour out.

*Acts 1:8 ...But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.*

Father, we come before You ... seeking Your divine guidance and strength as we embark on our evangelism outreach. Lord, remind us of the transformative power of Your love, and help us share that love with others. Open our hearts to the needs of those around us. Grant us the wisdom and discernment to be an effective witness of Your love and grace. That we be sensitive to their struggles and pain, and be vessels through which Your love can touch their lives. Let us not be hindered by fear or insecurity but rather be driven by compassion and empathy.

She will find comfort in knowing that You are in control and You are not surprised by anything. She will not be terrified because You go with her. You will never leave her nor forsake her. Amen.

## **Prayer Points**

### **1) Pray for Those Being Persecuted Because of the Gospel**

**...praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints— Ephesians 6:18**

- For protection and strength over believers.
- for the strength of their faith...to hold on to the promise that You work all things together for the good of those who love You. As Paul knew, may they know that all things are according to Your plan and are used to advance Your kingdom.
- To send angels to protect His children in these nations.
- That this persecution would cause a great revival and many would be saved.
- For those who persecute our brothers and sisters, let their spirits be touched by the incredible faith of those who they persecute... they turn away from sin and open their hearts to your love.
- Pray for the persecutors to stop and that they would get saved. God did it with Paul the apostle...He can do it again!!

**Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, 20for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should - Ephesians 6:19-20**

**9But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me. - 2 Corinthians 12:9**

### **2) A. Pray for our ongoing mission to SF**

- **Pray for protection and strength and for the spiritual health and unity of the team.**

10 Fear not [there is nothing to fear], for I am with you; do not look around you in terror and be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen and harden you to difficulties, yes, I will help you; yes, I will hold you up and retain you with My [victorious] right hand of rightness and justice. - **Isaiah 41:10**

The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore. **Psalm 121:8**

9 And let us not lose heart and grow weary and faint in acting nobly and doing right, for in due time and at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen and relax our courage and faint. – **Galatians 6:9**

5 Now may the God Who gives the power of patient endurance (steadfastness) and Who supplies encouragement, grant you to live in such mutual harmony and such full sympathy with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, 6 That together you may [unanimously] with united hearts and one voice, praise and glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah). – **Romans 15:5-6**

- **Pray that the joy of the Lord will sustain in every trial and setback.**

5 They who sow in tears shall reap in joy and singing. 6 He who goes forth bearing seed and weeping [at needing his precious supply of grain for sowing] shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him. – **Psalm 126:5-6**

- **Pray that the light of God would shine through the team, lifting darkness and oppression as they share His love.**

61 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed and qualified me to preach the Gospel of good tidings to the meek, the poor, and afflicted; He has sent me to bind up and heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the [physical and spiritual] captives and the opening of the prison and of the eyes to those who are bound. – **Isaiah 61:1**

- **Pray for open hearts...like the seeds that fell on fertile soil in the Parable of the Sower, we pray to make fertile ground and prepare the hearts to receive the gospel.**

7 And I will give them a heart to know (recognize, understand, and be acquainted with) Me, that I am the Lord; and they will be My people, and I will be their God, for they will return to Me with their whole heart. – **Jeremiah 24:7**

4 whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. 5 For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' sake. 6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. – **2Corinthians 4:4-6**

- **For God's provision for this mission trips to San Francisco**

19 And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. – **Philippians 4:19**

## **B. For all the participants of the Philippines' mission conference both in Manila and Palawan**

To continue to share the love of God and the message of the “Cry of the Bride in the end times.”

To increase in the understanding of Jesus as her Bridegroom King. For a divine revelation of His character.

28 And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming. – **1John 2:28**

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. – John 14:3

Your Word says in **Colossians 3:17**, “And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.” Thank you for the blessing to make new connections and gain wisdom to do the work you have set before us.

We declare that Your purposes will prevail. The apostle Paul encourages us with this truth in **Philippians 2:2**, “Then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.” Help us to be unified according to your Word. As we work together to fulfill your purpose, we commit to walk in grace, humility, and truth.

Continue to fill them with Your spirit of love as they edify and inspire one another to remain in the kingdom work You have called them to do. To be Your vessels of truth, love, and mercy as they work together, as one, in the Body of Christ.

8 Finally, all [of you] should be of one and the same mind (united in spirit), sympathizing [with one another], loving [each other] as brethren [of one household], compassionate and courteous (tenderhearted and humble). – **1Peter 3:8**

### **3) Pray for our YG and YG'S on all the nations:**

A) 2To pursue a deeper intimacy with the Lord, so that they don't wander off your path. Help them to grow in the knowledge of your word so that they are better equipped for the next challenge to come their way. Place a desire in the heart to not just know about You, but to desire a deeper, more personal faith and get to know You through the study of Your Word. Place in them a true hunger for your Word so they desire to know the Scripture, study it responsibly, teach it reverently, share it boldly, and live it faithfully as if it's the food that sustains them and the very air they breathe. Help them to recognize the difference between human philosophy and Godly wisdom by being diligent to study the Word, “accurately handling the word of truth (**2 Timothy 2:15**).

- B) Reveal your calling for their life and give them the courage to obey it. Help them pursue the desires of Your heart and Your will for their life with passion and persistence. Help them to press on with endurance regardless of the obstacles. That the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you. . . ”  
(Eph. 1:17–18).
- C) Raise up youth all over the world that are willing to step out in faith and pursue your calling for their life. Help them to become close together as the body of Christ, to support and love each other, and encourage each other through every circumstance. And Lord Jesus, as You prayed in **John 17:22-23**, to be “perfected in unity, so that the world may know that [Your Heavenly Father] sent [You],” and loved them, even as God has loved You.
- D) For this generation to be assured that You have created them in Your image and therefore they are fearfully and wonderfully made, full of purpose and uniqueness for Your glory....Your ways are perfect; You make no mistakes (**Psalm 18:30**) and they don’t have to question, second-guess, or reinvent their identity. To take care of their bodies as Your temple (**1 Corinthians 6:19**) and go through life boldly as Your handiwork, realizing the purposes You have for them before they were even born. That they not strive after their own significance or be led astray into thinking their own self-worthy (apart from Christ), but to live by the motto of Paul in **Galatians 2:20**: “I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me”
- E) To keep our young generation safe. Protect them from any harm or evil intent that would lurk close by, or attack them while they are unaware. Keep them safe in your powerful presence. Give them alertness, spirit discernment , and wisdom to avoid temptation. Thank you, Father God, that You walk ahead of them, beside them, and behind them.

#### 4) Pray for Southbay and San Pedro churches:

- A) Revival power...**Acts 4:24-31**

24 When they heard this, they raised their voices together in prayer to God. “Sovereign Lord,” they said, “you made the heavens and the earth and the sea, and everything in them. 25 You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of your servant, our father David: ““Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? 26 The kings of the earth rise up and the rulers band together against the Lord and against his anointed one. 27 Indeed Herod and Pontius Pilate met together with the Gentiles and the people of Israel in this city to conspire against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed. 28 They did what your power and will had decided beforehand should happen. 29 Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. 30 Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus.” 31 After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

B) Revival of Divine Revelation...**Ephesians 1:15-23**

15 For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all God's people, 16 I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers. 17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit[a] of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. 18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, 19 and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength 20 he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, 21 far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. 22 And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, 23 which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.

C)The Outpouring of Divine Love...**Ephesians 3:14-21**

14 For this reason I kneel before the Father, 15 from whom every family[a] in heaven and on earth derives its name. 16 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, 17 so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. 20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

D) The Release of the Prophetic...**Philippians 1:3-4,9-11**

3 I thank my God every time I remember you. 4 In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy.

9 And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, 10 so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, 11 filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

E) Filled with the knowledge of His will...**Colossians 1:2-4, 9-14**

2 To God's holy people in Colossae, the faithful brothers and sisters in Christ: Grace and peace to you from God our Father. 3 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, 4 because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all God's people.

9 For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives,<sup>[e]</sup> 10 so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, 11 being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, 12 and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you<sup>[f]</sup> to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light. 13 For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, 14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

F) Door of God... **Colossians 4:2-4, 12**

2 Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. 3 And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. 4 Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.

12 Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured.

G) The Established Heart... **1 Thessalonians 3:9-13, 5:23-24**

9 How can we thank God enough for you in return for all the joy we have in the presence of our God because of you? 10 Night and day we pray most earnestly that we may see you again and supply what is lacking in your faith. 11 Now may our God and Father himself and our Lord Jesus clear the way for us to come to you. 12 May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you. 13 May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones.

23 May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 The one who calls you is faithful, and he will do it.

H) Fulfill Your Call... **2 Thessalonians 1:3, 11-12**

3 We ought always to thank God for you, brothers and sisters,<sup>[a]</sup> and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love all of you have for one another is increasing.

11 With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith. 12 We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

I) Just Say "No"... **Titus 2:11-13**



11 For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. 12 It teaches us to say “No” to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, 13 while we wait for the blessed hope—the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.

J) Raise Up a House of Prayer... [Amos 9:11-12](#); [Acts 15:15-18](#); [Isaiah 56:7](#)

11 “In that day “I will restore David’s fallen shelter— I will repair its broken walls and restore its ruins and will rebuild it as it used to be, 12 so that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations that bear my name,” declares the Lord, who will do these things.

15 The words of the prophets are in agreement with this, as it is written:16 ““After this I will return and rebuild David’s fallen tent. Its ruins I will rebuild, and I will restore it, 17 that the rest of mankind may seek the Lord, even all the Gentiles who bear my name, says the Lord, who does these things’ 18 things known from long ago.

and who hold fast to my covenant—7 these I will bring to my holy mountain and give them joy in my house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house will be called a house of prayer for all nations.”

## 5) The Cry of the Bride...

A) Come, Lord Jesus, and fulfill your gracious promise to me to receive me to yourself.” Our Lord made many promises about His return - [John 14:3](#)

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

B) Come, Lord Jesus, for every time I take the bread and the wine I anticipate your coming again.” In [1 Corinthians 11:23-26](#) we have the order for remembering the Lord in His death. in v26 – “until he comes”.

23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, [a]“Take, eat; this is My body which is [b]broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” 25 In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.” 26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death till He comes.

17 And the Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let him who hears say, “Come!” And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely. – [Revelation 22:17](#)

The Bride joyfully anticipates the coming of the Bridegroom, when there will be the marriage supper of the Lamb – [Revelation 19:6-9](#)

6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! 7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." 8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. 9 Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!'" And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God."

C) Come, Lord Jesus, and help me to live for you as I wait, watch and work, so that I shall not be ashamed at your coming. - **1 John 2:28**... that a loving Bride will keep herself pure for her Bridegroom.

28 And now, little children, abide (live, remain permanently) in Him, so that when He is made visible, we may have and enjoy perfect confidence (boldness, assurance) and not be ashamed and shrink from Him at His coming.

10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. 11 Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, 12 looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? 13 Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. 14 Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless; - **2Peter 3: 10-14**

D) Come, Lord Jesus, for I am waiting to see You as You are, and to be changed into your likeness." --**1 John 3:1-3**

3 Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know [us, because it did not know Him. 2 Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. 3 And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

Every day we should be being changed into His likeness --**2 Corinthians 3:18**

18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

and God's ultimate purpose is that we should be conformed to His image --**Romans 8:29**.. Because the Bridegroom is perfect in His character the Bride longs to be like Him.

29 or whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

E) Let us each search our own hearts before the Lord seeking the Lord in Spirit and Truth. We must have pure hearts before the Lord for nothing is hidden before the Lord and there is no “secret sin” or ungodly covenants that are hidden from the Lord. Let us be awakened to the urgency of the times we live in and seek Matthew 6:33 the righteousness of Christ Jesus and His Kingdom and His will not ours. It is time for the fear of the Lord to be in the hearts of His chosen and to have no other love placed before the Love of the Lord Jesus.

**Isaiah 26:9** (AMP)...9 My soul yearns for You [O Lord] in the night, yes, my spirit within me seeks You earnestly; for [only] when Your judgments are in the earth will the inhabitants of the world learn righteousness (uprightness and right standing with God).

**Psalms 19:9** (AMP)...9 The [reverent] fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the ordinances of the Lord are true and righteous altogether

F) Awaken the Bride of Christ, repent and return to the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob!

**Ephesians 5:14** (AMP)...14 Therefore He says, Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall shine (make day dawn) upon you and give you light.

As the Lord says to you, “Yes, I am coming soon”, will you not cry out with great joy, “Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!

## 6) Prayer for Families

- Pray and ask God to go with the family...to dedicate the family to the hands of God. Pray that His presence will always go before and after them wherever they are. Speak a covering over each member of the family.

**“And he said unto him, if thy presence go not with me, carry us not up hence” (Exodus 33:15).**

- Dedicate the family to serving the Lord... to disconnect from every affiliation from previous generations. For the blood of His son Jesus Christ to break any covenants made in the family bloodline with other gods. Pray against generational curses. Declare that the family is God’s, and you all are moving forward in Jesus’ name.

**“And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord” (Joshua 24:15).**

- Pray for the release of vision into the home ... to pour vision into the home. To release dreams into every member of the family. Pray against all kinds of stagnancy and declare progression into all they do.

**“Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he” (Proverbs 29:18).**

- Pray for unity in the family.... for family members be in peace and unity with one another. To embrace and practice the core values of the family for the well-being of all. To feel loved and respected in the family. To be committed to the good of one another all the time. To not nurture anger in our hearts for it to lead to resentment, bitterness and even hatred. To resolve our conflicts openly, honestly and promptly. To be humble to admit our faults and to seek forgiveness, love and when we have wronged others. To seek peace so as to maintain the unity of the family. In the name of Jesus, Amen.

**1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! 2 It is like the precious ointment poured on the head, that ran down on the beard, even the beard of Aaron [the first high priest], that came down upon the collar and skirts of his garments [consecrating the whole body]. 3 It is like the dew of [lofty] Mount Hermon and the dew that comes on the hills of Zion; for there the Lord has commanded the blessing, even life forevermore [upon the high and the lowly]. – Psalm 133**

- Father, thank you as You bless the family with good health... send divine health to the family. Lord, maintain our loved ones' health. Destroy all forms of sickness in Jesus' name.

**“And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee” (Exodus 23:25).**

**2 Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and [that your body] may keep well, even as [I know] your soul keeps well and prospers. – 3 John 1:2**

- For the family to pray for the children... Children are the heritage of God. Pray for the parents to raise them the way the Lord wants them to. Pray for wisdom for parents to nurture their children in the way of the Lord. Pray against any hindrance that would stand against them in knowing God. Preserve our children and keep their purity.

**But Jesus said, “Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven” (Matthew 19:14).**

- Pray for Parents... Pray that God would raise fathers in this fatherless generation who stand in the gap. To give fathers the wisdom they require to lead and make them humble. Pray and bring the mothers into the hands of God to strengthen them in their daily challenges. That mothers will never feel inadequate for the task and they are geared up for such a time as this in Jesus' name. Amen.

**“Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it” Proverbs 22:6).**

Father, thank you for meeting the family's financial needs ... for the promises He would meet and supply all our needs in **Philippians 4:19** **“But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”** Thank You for daily meeting the needs of all family members. Speak His blessings over all family members. Declare that you all will reap whatever you have sowed.

## **7) Pray for your leaders, both governmental and spiritual...**

Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. – 1 Timothy 2:1-4

Pray for spiritual leaders:

- Cover your spiritual leaders in prayer by praying for protection, wisdom, strength, grace, peace.
- Pray that they would be protected from temptation, fiery darts, and snares of the devil.
- Pray for their hearts to burn for passion for God. To love and devour His word, walk in truth, and purity.
- Pray they would preach the word with Boldness and be sensitive to the Holy Spirit.

**But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. – Isaiah 40:31**

**A deer longs for streams of water. God, I long for you in the same way. I am thirsty for God. I am thirsty for the living God. When can I go and meet with him? – Psalm 42:1-2**

Pray for governmental leaders:

- Pray for your leaders to come to knowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord and Savior. And if they do know the Lord that their relationship with Him would grow and prosper.
- Pray for they would have Godly wisdom and laws would NOT be passed that go against God's Word.
- Pray that God would surround these individuals with people that know the Lord and would be a mouthpiece for Him.
- Pray for protection over any scheme of man or the enemy that would cause this leader to make wrong decisions both governmental and personally.

**Psalm 22:28 “For kingship belongs to the Lord, and he rules over the nations.”**

**Psalm 33:12 “How blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people he has chosen as his own inheritance.”**

**Isaiah 46:10** “Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, ‘My purpose will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure.’”

**8) Pray for us, Forerunners for Christ (LA/Philippines)** - individually and corporately to grow in humility; surrendering and submitting to the Lord and the leadership of the Holy Spirit. Pray for us individually and corporately to be transformed and conformed into Christlikeness.

2 Corinthians 3:18, Matthew 11:29, 1 Peter 5:1-6, Matthew 18:4, Isaiah 66:2

- Father, Your word says that the church is your bride. Your people have been washed clean and purified by your blood. Your people have been clothed in your righteousness. You love the church, you died for the church, you pray for the church, you sustain the church. Fill your people with the knowledge and experience of your love. To live in harmony with one another, that together we may with one voice glorify you. – **Philippians 1:9-11**
- To work together as members of one body, using the gifts and abilities you have given us to faithfully love and serve one another. To increase and abound in love for each other. Establish our hearts as blameless in holiness before you. – **Romans 12:3-8**
- For your church be like a city on a hill, shining your light into the darkness of the world. – **Matthew 5:14-16**
- To be fruitful as we seek to build each other up into maturity in Christ. Let your love be the passion in our hearts. For joy be our strength. For your presence be our peace that overflows. – **Colossians 1:9-10**
- For every Forerunner member to return to walk in the fear of God. For a revelation of the fear of God.

10 He takes no pleasure in the strength of a horse or in human might. 11 No, the Lord’s delight is in those who fear him, those who put their hope in his unfailing love. – **Psalm 147:10-11**

8 Let the whole world fear the Lord and let everyone stand in awe of him. -- **Psalm 33:8**

10 The reverent fear and worship of the Lord is the beginning of [a]Wisdom and skill [the preceding and the first essential, the prerequisite and the alphabet]; a good understanding, wisdom, and meaning have all those who do [the will of the Lord]. Their praise of Him endures forever. -- **Psalm 111:10**

12 “And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with

all your soul, 13 and to keep the commandments of the Lord and His statutes which I command you today for your good?-- **Deuteronomy 10: 12-13**

- Pray for every Forerunner to return to an understanding of the righteousness of God. For a revelation of righteousness of God.

17 For if because of one man's trespass (lapse, offense) death reigned through that one, much more surely will those who receive [God's] overflowing grace (unmerited favor) and the free gift of righteousness [putting them into right standing with Himself] reign as kings in life through the one Man Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One).-- **Romans 5:17**

21 For our sake He made Christ [virtually] to be sin Who knew no sin, so that in and through Him we might become [endued with, viewed as being in, and examples of] the righteousness of God [what we ought to be, approved and acceptable and in right relationship with Him, by His goodness]. --**2 Corinthians 5:21**

- A) For I am not ashamed of the gospel [a]of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."-- **Romans 1:16-17**

## **9) Pray for Israel**

Lord, speak to Your people following that true freedom is only found in Messiah Yeshua who can set people free from their bondage to their sin nature

**John 8:36 ... 36 So if the Son liberates you [makes you free men], then you are really and unquestionably free.**

Lord, without Your intervention, Israel would not have been resurrected, but it was Your time to have mercy on Zion (Psa. 102:13); and so Israel is back as Your witness (Isa. 43:10-12; 44:8).

**Psalm 102:13....13 You will arise and have mercy and loving-kindness for Zion, for it is time to have pity and compassion for her; yes, the set time has come [the moment designated].**

**Isaiah 43:10-12.... You are My witnesses, says the Lord, and My servant whom I have chosen, that you may know Me, believe Me and remain steadfast to Me, and understand that I am He. Before Me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after Me.11 I, even I, am the Lord, and besides Me there is no Savior.12 I have declared [the future] and have saved [the nation in times of danger], and I have shown [that I am God]—when there was no strange and alien god among you; therefore you are My witnesses, says the Lord, that I am God.**

**Isaiah 44:8... 8 Fear not, nor be afraid [in the coming violent upheavals]; have I not told it to you from of old and declared it? And you are My witnesses! Is there a God besides Me? There is no [other] Rock; I know not any.**

Because of Your faithfulness Israel still exists as a nation today; and since You are faithful to Your – as yet – unsaved nation, how much more will You be faithful to us (Mal. 3:6; Phil. 1:6)! Amen! Confound all the atheists and confront all the agnostics with the miracle not only of Israel's rebirth – but its continued existence and prosperity (Isa. 61:6-9).

**Malachi 3:6...6 For I am the Lord, I do not change; that is why you, O sons of Jacob, are not consumed.**

**Philippians 1:6 ....6And I am convinced and sure of this very thing, that He Who began a good work in you will continue until the day of Jesus Christ [right up to the time of His return], developing [that good work] and perfecting and bringing it to full completion in you.**

**Isaiah 61: 6-9... 6But you shall be named the priests of the Lord, They shall call you the servants of our God. You shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, And in their glory you shall boast.7 Instead of your shame you shall have double honor, And instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; Everlasting joy shall be theirs. 8 “For I, the Lord, love justice; I hate robbery [a]for burnt offering; I will direct their work in truth,And will make with them an everlasting covenant. 9 Their descendants shall be known among the Gentiles, And their offspring among the people. All who see them shall acknowledge them, That they are the posterity whom the Lord has blessed.”**

Abba, draw Your people home (Jer. 31:3-5).

**Jeremiah 31:3-5 ...3 The Lord has appeared of old to me, saying: “Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you. 4 Again I will build you, and you shall be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel! You shall again be adorned with your tambourines, And shall go forth in the dances of those who rejoice. 5 You shall yet plant vines on the mountains of Samaria; The planters shall plant and eat them as ordinary food.**

**“Thus says the Lord of hosts: ‘Behold, I will save My people from the land of the east and from the land of the west; I will bring them back and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. They shall be My people and I will be their God in truth and righteousness.’” (Zechariah 8:7)**

Father, since You hold the heart of all of Israel's "kings" in Your hands, please turn them in the direction of Your will for Your nation at this time (Prov. 21:1).



**1 The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, like the [a]rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes.**

Since the beginning of 2022, over 100,000 new immigrants have moved to Israel, marking the highest number in three decades. Over 60,000 came from Russia, 20,000 from Ukraine, and another 20,000 from all over the world.

Father, encourage Your people to make Aliyah in order to save their lives – even at the loss of their lifestyles (Joel 3:16).

**16 The Lord will thunder and roar from Zion and utter His voice from Jerusalem, and the heavens and the earth shall shake; but the Lord will be a refuge for His people and a stronghold to the children of Israel.**

Father, thank You, that You continue to bless Israel. Thank You that You have chosen to bless the world through the Jewish people!

**“The LORD had said unto Abram, ‘Get out of your country, from your kindred, and your father's house, unto a land that I will show you. I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great. And you shall be a blessing...and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed’” (Genesis 12:1-3)**

#### **10) Pray for a Great Awakening and for Salvations**

**‘And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams. – Acts 2:17**

**3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,. – 1 Timothy 2:3-5**

For Christians to desire for the lost to come to Christ and for an outpouring of His Spirit to take place:

- Pray that hearts would become soft and turn to God. That people would have an incredible experience with Jesus. That they would repent and be born again!
- For the prodigal sons and daughter to return to God.
- For a revival and an outpouring of God's Spirit to fall on your church, city, state, nations
- For workers in the field (Those working in the ministry)
- Pray for the church to have a prayer burden for the lost.

- Pray for the saints to be equipped for a great harvest
- Pray for world leaders and people of influence to turn to God.

## 11) For The Body of Christ To Be In Unity and Walk In Love

Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. – 1 Corinthians 1:10

By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.– John 13:35

- **Pray for the church to walk in God's love and experience God's love in a greater way.**

Ephesians 5:1-2 Therefore be imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father].<sup>2</sup> And walk in love, [esteeming and delighting in one another] as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us, a slain offering and sacrifice to God [for you, so that it became] a sweet fragrance.

- **For the church to release what it means, love covers a multitude of sins.**

1 Peter 4:8...<sup>8</sup> Above all things have intense and unfailing love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins [forgives and [a]disregards the offenses of others].

- **For unity within the body. That disaccord, disunity, offense, and rejection would have no place in the church.**

Colossians 3:12-14...<sup>12</sup> Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; <sup>13</sup> bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. <sup>14</sup> But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

- **For those whose hearts have been hurt to be healed and for reconciliation to take place.**

2 Corinthians 5:17-20...<sup>17</sup> Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. <sup>18</sup> Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, <sup>19</sup> that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not [a]imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

- **For protection for those in church leadership and those in the congregation. That every scheme and plan of the enemy would fail.**

Matthew 16:15-19...15 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" 16 Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." 17 Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. 18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. 19 And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth [b]will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, 3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. – 2 Peter 1:2-4

## **12) Pray for intercessors in the USA and around the world:**

- 16 And He saw that there was no man and wondered that there was no intercessor [no one to intervene on behalf of truth and right]; therefore His own arm brought Him victory, and His own righteousness [having the Spirit without measure] sustained Him.  
**Isaiah 59:16**

Father, help us to become one who worships you and who lives in holy relationship to You...to get into the joy of intercession through and in prayer, to rouse ourselves up to lay hold of His mind as we pray. Awake your church to receive new mantles of prayer and hear Your appointment in intercession. Birth in them a holy desperation for prayer. Give us men, women and children who seek Your mind and heart to pray Your prayers...not just to pray to You but pray with You.

To commit to stand together to contend for the unity of faith, advancement of His Kingdom and His promises that transcends generational, cultural, political and gender barriers.

- **John 17:20-21:** "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me."
- **Isaiah 55:9-11** For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts. "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.
- **Isaiah 52:8** Your watchmen shall lift up their voices, With their voices they shall sing together; For they shall see eye to eye when the LORD brings back Zion

- 26 So too the [Holy] Spirit comes to our aid and bears us up in our weakness; for we do not know what prayer to offer nor how to offer it worthily as we ought, but the Spirit Himself goes to meet our supplication and pleads in our behalf with unspeakable yearnings and groanings too deep for utterance. 27 And He Who searches the hearts of men knows what is in the mind of the [Holy] Spirit [what His intent is], because the Spirit intercedes and pleads [before God] in behalf of the saints according to and in harmony with God's will. -- **Romans 8:26-27**

To pray before God in humility that God may be glorified and the focus isn't on us, but rather on Him. We must maintain a selfless attitude as we intercede for others (Romans 15:1-2) and remember that it's not about our abilities or gifts, but all about Jesus and what He has done!

- 6 But He gives us more and more grace (power of the Holy Spirit, to meet this evil tendency and all others fully). That is why He says, God sets Himself against the proud and haughty, but gives grace [continually] to the lowly (those who are humble enough to receive it). **James 4:6 AMPC**

To be Sensitive to The Holy Spirit: to pray in a divine manner to bring forth His will on earth as it already is in heaven.

As believers, we are all indwelt by the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 3:16; 6:19) who gives us wisdom (Luke 12:11) and understanding (1 Cor 2:15), reveals deep things about God (1 Corinthians 2:10), convicts us of sin, righteousness, and judgment (John 16:8).

- 13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future. --**John 16:13**

We claim victory over Satan by putting on the whole armor of God!

- We put on the Girdle of Truth....to stand firm in the truth of Your Word so we will not be a victim of Satan's lies.
- We put on the Breastplate of Righteousness...to guard our hearts from evil so we will remain pure and holy, protected under the blood of Jesus Christ.
- We put on the Shoes of Peace...to stand firm in the Good News of the Gospel so Your peace will shine through us and be a light to all we encounter.
- We take the Shield of Faith ... to discern Satan's fiery darts of doubt, denial, and deceit so we will not be vulnerable to spiritual defeat.
- We put on the Helmet of Salvation...to keep our minds focused on You so Satan will not have a stronghold on our thoughts.
- We take the Sword of the Spirit...for the two-edged sword of Your Word be ready in our hands so we can expose the tempting words of Satan.
- By faith we put on the whole armor of God... prepared to live in spiritual victory! Amen!
